


"Protection of Threatened Pear Species and Securing Viability of their Populations in Armenia", 2020-2023





The main goal of the project is protection of five globally threatened endemic pear species in the wild (*in-situ*) through populations' **restoration by reinforcement** and monitoring. The project contributes also to *ex-situ* conservation of the target species through collection and storage of seeds in the seed bank, establishment of nurseries and through enrichment of the living collection in Yerevan Botanical Garden.
